 - a. Steve Pierce from CV Chamber of Commerce thanked council for taking down the election signage on Foothill Blvd. After Pancake Breakfast on Saturday come to clean up Foothill Blvd in conjunction with City of Glendale. He invited all to come to the Chamber Dinner Oct 28 , \$45/person.
 - b. Marta Wiggins from the library was happy to report no leaks from season rains, The Friends book sale was a success. She thanked the CVTC for an anonymous donation of 3 much needed books.
 - c. Mary O'Keefe for the Drug & Alcohol Coalition reported they had received their grant of \$625k over the next five years. They are working on cleaning up the old fire house on St. Luke's property and making it a youth house with Tuesday from 6 to 9 PM for high school.
