1. What would you like to see the Town Council accomplish?

I would like the Town Council to continue its efforts to make the streets in our community as safe as they possibly can be. This goes for both pedestrian traffic as well as the many bicycle riders in our community. In my opinion, this will be accomplished by continuing to work with DPW and Kathryn Barger's office to see if various improvements (Speed feedback signs, additional stop signs, flashing crosswalks, crossing guards) can be implemented. I also believe that getting a safe routes to school plan for the unincorporated part of La Crescenta would go a long way in making the streets safe for our children walking to and from school.

I would also like to see the Council come up with a plan to get ahead of AB-516 if it is passed. I think this could become a major concern for the residents of our community. Continuing the proactive approach we have already begun is the right path to continue on.

I believe getting an Open Streets grant application for our community would be very beneficial. It brings the community together for a fun event which in turn builds some level of comradery between the participants. Also, being that we need to find future modes of transportation besides motor vehicles, it's a good way to get people to experience other more active modes of transportation.

2. As a new member of the Town Council, what would be your goals for the next year or what would you hope to contribute to the Town Council?

I hope to contribute my time and efforts to make a positive difference in my community.

The schools of La Crescenta consistently receive acclaim in a variety of areas for the education they provide the children of our community. I want to continue to work with GUSD to support them in any way we can to continue this tradition. That could include fund-raising events, youth town council support, or any other way we can maintain the level of excellence that has been ongoing for many years now. "Children are our future" isn't just a catchphrase, it's a reality.

I want to continue my community outreach to get the message out that the CVTC meets regularly and needs to hear concerns and ideas to better serve the community.

Campaign Code of Conduct

There are basic principles of decency, honesty, and fair play that every candidate for public office in the State of California has a moral obligation to observe and uphold. THEREFORE:

1. I SHALL CONDUCT my campaign in good faith and show respect for my fellow candidates.
2. I SHALL OBTAIN the private property owner's permission before placing or allowing others to place my campaign signs/posters on their property.
3. I SHALL DEFEND AND UPHOLD the right of every qualified voter to full and equal participation in the electoral process.
4. I SHALL REMOVE all campaign materials within 48 hours of the election.
5. I SHALL NOT defame, libel, or slander, any candidate or his or her family.
6. I SHALL NOT USE NOR PERMIT any appeal to prejudice based on race, gender, religion, national origin, physical health status, or age.
7. I SHALL NOT USE NOR PERMIT any dishonest or unethical practice including acts intended to hinder or prevent any eligible person from registering to vote, enrolling to vote, or voting.
8. I SHALL NOT PERMIT NOR CONDONE any removal or destruction of any opponent's signs, brochures, flyers, or other campaign material.
9. I SHALL NOT PLACE NOR PERMIT others involved in my campaign to place campaign materials in illegal locations (i.e. telephone poles¹, public fencing², trees in the right of way³, light poles⁴, on or inside mailboxes⁵). See ordinances below.
10. I SHALL NOT PERMIT NOR CONDONE campaign literature, or an individual or individuals to electioneer, within 100 feet of the polling location on Election Day.
